Here are a few reminders: Pressure cleaning roofs, driveways, walkways, gutters, garden borders if you have any discoloration. Mailboxes: paint post, replace post/mailbox and numbers as needed. Please remember to check the web site for the approved post and box. Lawns: mowing, weeding garden beds, mulching, treating weeds, replace barren sod areas, trim shrubs, trim Palm and Oak trees. Please check your garage door/house to see if you have any discoloration, chalky, faded paint; cleaning or repainting is necessary. If you are changing colors of trim, house, garage or front door, an ARC request is necessary. Reminder: 5.5 in our Covenants states all "totes/receptacles" must be screened from view from the street and adjacent lots.

2020 has brought many updated projects to Colonial Pointe. The road has been resealed. This continues to help with the integrity of the road itself and several "pot holes" were filled in. The lighting on the front and corner signage was upgraded, they were the original, with LED lights that last longer and burn brighter. (So bright that they were stolen.) Our pedestrian and front gates will be painted in January. The trees along the east side were trimmed and the front trees will be trimmed in 2021. You may have noticed the major refresh of plants at our entrance and across the front. 65 new plants were updated.
